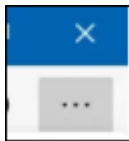


Chromium Edge browser - How to clear the Cache and Cookies

Note – The Chromium Edge browser has this symbol:



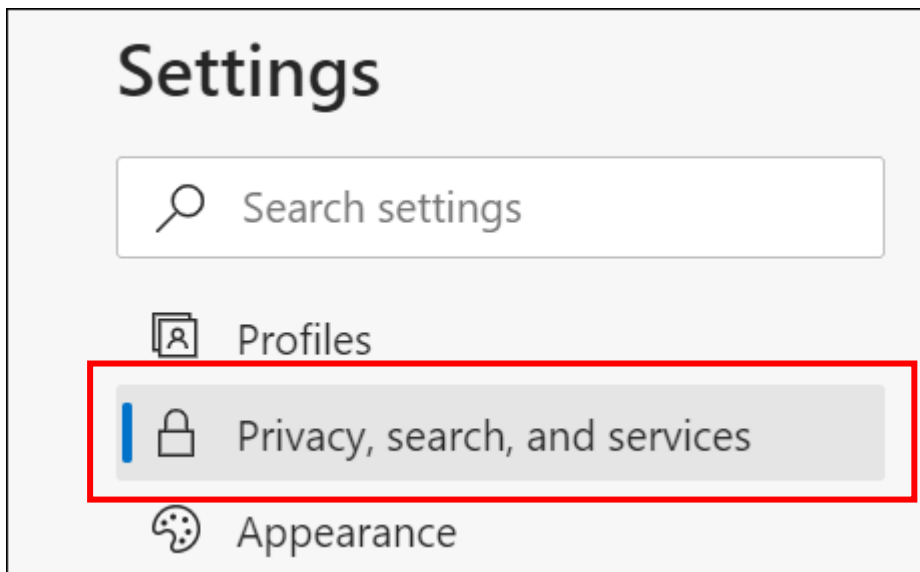
1. Select the 3 dots from the top righthand side of the browser



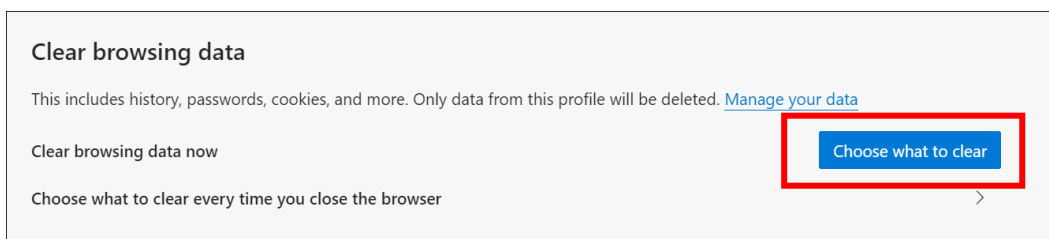
2. Select **Settings**



3. Select **Privacy, search, and services**



4. Using the righthand scroll, scroll down until you find **Clear browsing data**. Then select **Choose what to clear**.



5. The below Clear browsing data box appears. In this box:
 - a. From Time range select **All Time**.
 - b. Only have the boxes **Cookies and other site data** and **Cached images and files** ticked.
 - c. Select **Clear now**
