



Recordbase 5.34 release notes

Wild Bamboo is proud to announce the release of Recordbase 5.34.

This release includes the ability to record a note against individuals in a group activity, a collection of improvements that make configuration easier, plus lots of other little improvements behind the scenes.

All this work, both the new features and the enhancements to existing features, came about because you asked us for it – so thank you for the guidance! As always, we're keen to hear feedback on this work (what's great, what's not, what would make it better?) and any ideas you have for further improvements and developments. Recordbase is your system after all, so tell us what you need it to do.

As with all Recordbase releases, this upgrade is free of charge. You will be upgraded automatically by the Wild Bamboo team, which will require a small out-of-hours outage. 


New features in 5.34

Record individual notes against group activity participants

Group activities have always included notes, but a group activity note is shared by every participant in the group. You told us that sometimes, you also need to add separate notes against individual group participants – and that it would also be useful to link a group activity to individual participants' goals or employment plans.

In 5.34, the view screen for a group activity now includes an *Add details* link for every participant, as shown below. Record your group activity like normal, and then add individual details as required. You can add a client-specific note as well as links to goals, employment plans, protocols, and purchase orders.





Delete a person record

We all wish that we could get things right the first time, every time, but sometimes mistakes happen – for example, sometimes incorrect referrals are entered in Recordbase. Previously, deleting a person record was a task that could only be completed by the Wild Bamboo support team. While we love to hear from you, we figured you would rather be able to fix things yourself. Now you can.

To delete a person, simply click the Delete button on the main details section of the personal details tab.



If there are attached items preventing the deletion, Recordbase will let you know.



As the message says, it is **very** important to note that when you delete a person, every piece of information attached to their record goes with them – make sure you're certain before clicking the button! Access to the person delete button is controlled by role permissions, so get in touch with the support team at support@wildbamboo.co.nz to go through how it works in more detail, and then grant the person deletion permission to the appropriate role(s) within your organisation.



Support enhancements

Looking back through the Wild Bamboo support queue, we noticed some common support requests. Currently, we charge a small fee to cover our time for these tasks, but we think a better solution would be to build this functionality within Recordbase and then provide it to you as self-service support.

For the first iteration of these new features, we have restricted them to Wild Bamboo access only. This means our Level 2 support team will have an entire release cycle to use and improve them before we provide them to you in 5.35, a process that we have used before, and which worked very well. For now, you'll benefit from a much faster turnaround and reduced (or no) cost for these common requests:


- Adding other participant types to activities
- Adding person interaction types to teams
- Configuring purchase order service units

Enhancements to existing features in 5.34

To everyone who gave us feedback and suggested ideas for improvements – thank you! Here's what you told us you wanted, and here's what we did about it.

Updated date picker

We had some great feedback on the date pickers we introduced last year, and a common request was to use it for entering dates of birth – so we added it to the new referral wizard. Now you can use the new date picker to type a client's date of birth directly in, rather than using the mouse to select from the calendar. In case you're a fan of the mouse, we also added shortcuts to the year component, so now you can quickly hop back through the decades rather than scrolling.





Reporting improvements


Some of you have been using the Recordbase reporting database for a while now and have enjoyed having direct access to your own data. In this release, we're taking some of the things learned from our new reporting format and applying them to the standard reports in Recordbase.


This means we are better able to hunt down those occasional performance issues that creep up, and can more easily resolve them. This is a continuation of our journey towards providing you with better access to your data.

This means no functional changes for you, but you will notice a difference in the way the navigation controls look on the Calendar and Clients tabs, as shown below.







Appendix II – Bug fixes
